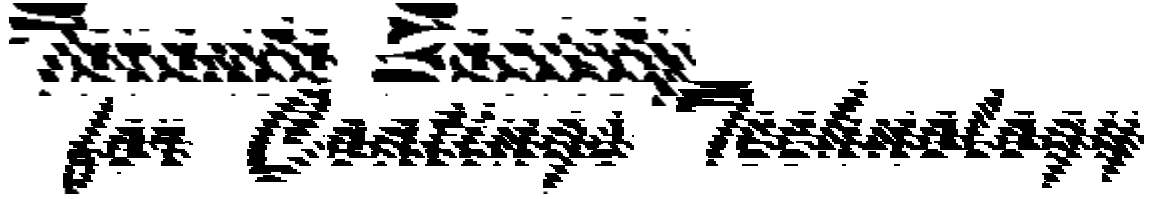

Dear Members,

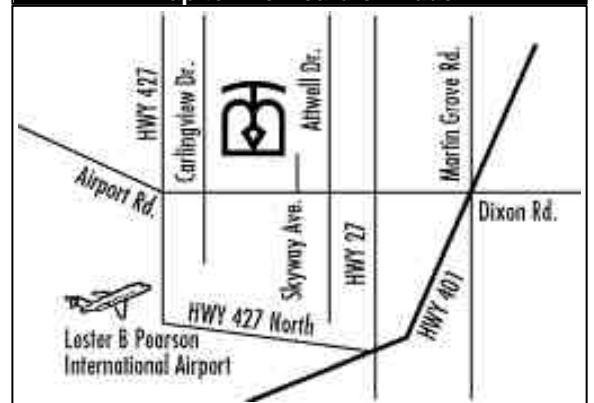

Topic & Speaker


Abstract: Since 1969, Cementitious polyurethane flooring products have been used in the UK and Europe. Now with the expired patent held by Shearing at ICI, this market has opened up to other manufacturers. With the changes in the Food and Pharmaceutical regulations regarding acceptable flooring for manufacturing plants and the increase in the environmental regulations for solvent reduction, the next generation of floor coatings in the market have been 100% solids or solvent free systems. This paper will outline the chemistry of concrete as a substrate, and give an overview of the existing high build resin flooring systems that exist in the marketplace. Some of the floorings covered will be cementitious polyurethane, polyurea, epoxy, acrylics (polymethylmethacrylates) and inorganic sealers. The benefits and limitations of each will be discussed.

Biography of Speaker: Raymond Bower is the lead research and development polymer Chemist for Covercrete Flooring Systems. Covercrete Canada is a manufacturer of cementitious modified polymer flooring materials, specializing in high build 100% solid polyurethane and epoxy floors for the pharmaceutical, food and industrial market. Raymond has more than 12 years of experience holding various positions in formulation chemistry, research & development, technical services, quality assurance and quality control in the coating industry. After graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in applied analytical chemistry and a Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy from the University of Guelph in 1991, Raymond took a ten year field apprenticeship with an experienced paint chemist named Harry Smith, the founder and owner of Temuss product of Canada. Temuss product is Canada's oldest shellac refinery. Temuss presently refines shellac for the food and pharmaceutical markets. Raymond is a member of the Toronto Society of Coating Technologies, presently holding the position of director of programming, and is a member of the federal society of coatings technologies.

May 31 is deadline for 2005 scholarship applications

Your Society has established a scholarship fund for your children considering post-secondary education (college or university).

The maximum \$2000 scholarship is designed to encourage young people to continue their education. Although preference is given to those considering enrolling in science programs, unlike some industry-connected scholarships, applicants who have selected a non-science related field of study would also be considered.

If there are no applicants in the field of science, the scholarship will be awarded to applicants enrolled in other programs. Funds for the scholarship come from money contributed by the members in 1970.

In the event that the number of applicants meriting a scholarship is greater than one, the amount awarded per applicant may be scaled down. Alternatively, should the growth of the capital fund amount warrant it, the trustees will contribute a second full scholarship.

Four trustees from the Executive Committee manage the scholarship fund; they also select the recipient(s). The scholarship cheque(s) is (are) presented annually at the September meeting.











The DSCT 30th Annual FOCUS Conference will be held at the MSU Educational Conference Center in Troy, MI. on May 5, 2005.
